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

CHNA and Improvement Planning Process

Community Health Needs Assessment

 A structured process, usually conducted in <u>collaboration</u> with other community groups and organizations for determining the health status and needs of community members and identifying community health improvement programs and services on which to focus.

Improvement Plan

- A long-term, systematic effort to address public health problems in a community. The plan is based on the results of the Community Health Needs Assessment activities, and is part of a community health improvement process.
- Developed through a <u>collaborative</u> process, and defines a vision for the health of the community.
